On November 1, 1924, at the age of fifty-one, Cantagallo suffered a stroke, which left him unable to walk. He wrote a letter to the prime minister and the newspaper La Nazione, informing them of his inability to continue his "traveling talk show", and asking for his resignation as "county head". It is said that these letters are the only things he wrote in his lifetime. He died from the stroke two days later at his residence on the island of Sardinia. Legacy Despite his relatively short, but productive career, Cantagallo had had a major impact on 20th-century European culture, and his work continues to be studied and debated by students of history and philosophy. His essays, which range from an analysis of the relationship between cinema and Italy's national character to a polemic against Cagliostro (written in 1932), have been praised as timeless and contemporary. Cantagallo was the subject of two plays: by German playwright René Fülöp-Müller (1925) and by the Italian Futurist poet Inigo Eraso (1926). Cantagallo was also the subject of a 1934 Italian film adaptation, in which he was played by actor Giulio Mastroni 82157476af
